THE **PODIATRIST** PROFESSION

The Podiatrist examines and treats all disorders of the foot.

He prescribes, designs and creates orthopaedic soles to correct and relieve painful conditions, static and dynamic disorders and inequalities in the length of the lower limbs.

The Podiatrist also prescribes certain products imposed by a decree of the Ministry of Health, and suggests exercises for functional rehabilitation.

Erasmus+

Thus, the students of the Institute have the opportunity for internships in China, Vietnam, Japan, the United States, Australia and all over Europe.

The École d'Assas also participates in the Erasmus + Program for Higher Education.

THE PHYSIOTHERAPIST PROFESSION

As a rehabilitation specialist, the physiotherapist treats people with musculoskeletal, neuromuscular, cardiovascular, respiratory or psychomotor disorders. He prevents, restores and maintains the altered functional capacities of the patient, thus making it possible to restore or supplement the patient's activities.

On the basis of the patient's clinical medical file and through technical evaluations, he conducts a physiotherapy examination of the patient to define a health care plan and establish a prognosis. He selects the actions and techniques best suited for each patient: infants, elderly persons, sportspersons, musicians, etc.





STRENGTHS

- Apprentice training program (CFA): IFMK students have the opportunity to pursue training while being employed by a health institution. They receive remuneration and their tuition fees are fully borne by their employer.

- IFMK, in connection with healthcare facilities, enables access to on-the-job training contracts and contracts for educational grants.

THE OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST PROFESSION

The occupational therapist is a rehabilitation specialist who works through medical prescriptions. He contributes to the treatment of motor, neuropsychological disorders,

or social problems in people of all ages. He offers technical solutions (useful, creative,

recreational) for activities in daily life and professional life, to provide solutions in different areas: communication, furnishing, food, and mobility to help patients regain greater independence on daily life field cover.

He examines the nature of the disability in order to offer personalised assistance. He performs an assessment of the patient's capacity for movement and creates a report on the patient's autonomy: dressing, movement and eating. Based on the identified needs, he establishes an individual program.

The occupational therapist is a health professional working in a multidisciplinary team composed of physiotherapists and podiatrists. He practices in hospitals, clinics, functional rehabilitation centres, residences, medical & social centres, etc.

♦ STRENGTHS

- Established within a day care facility for persons with disabilities, the Institute has all the facilities adapted for training its students (therapeutic apartment).

- **Changes in society** with the gradual inclusion of persons with disabilities in ordinary situations, thus creating **new perspectives** in professional practice: **Domestic medical systems, connected health services.**

 - Connected health services.


